

CAMP BEAVERFORK RULES

1. All campers must be in designated areas at all times.
2. There is to be no physical contact between campers.
3. No camper may leave camp without written permission of the camp director, dean of women, or dean of men. Campers may only leave with parent or legal guardian.
4. All monies need to be turned in for concessions/beaver bucks upon registration. The camp will not be responsible for lost or stolen money.
5. All relationship issues will be handled according to Matthew 18. Work together to work out any conflicts.
6. Gripping, complaining, bullying and bad attitudes will not be tolerated.
7. Disrespect, disobedience, or any issue that warrants attention should be reported to the dean of men, dean of women, or camp director immediately.
8. We are not trained, equipped, or staffed to handle youth with extreme behavioral, medical, etc. issues.
9. All medications must be turned in to the dean of men, dean of women or medical personnel upon arriving at camp.
10. No alcohol, tobacco products, illegal drugs, profanity, or pornography are allowed at camp.
11. Electronic devices **will not be** allowed at camp: cell phones, iPods, mp3 players, radios, alarm clocks with radios, portable game systems, etc. (Please leave these at home)
12. Do not deface or destroy camp property. Campers and their parents or legal guardians may be held responsible for damages.
13. Dress code is as follows:
Campers, their parents /legal guardians, and church sponsors are responsible for helping make sure their child/children follow the dress guidelines. Bring clothing appropriate for both worship service and activity time.
Dress code for Campers / Sponsors (Daily Activities): All clothing worn by campers and workers must be knee length. This includes jeans, shorts, sweats, or any other style pant. All clothing must be loose fitting, including sweats. **NOT ALLOWED:** Tank tops, spandex / Yoga / Leggin Style pants and T-shirts with suggestive logos or writing.
Dress code for Females (Worship Service): Dresses or skirts and blouses must be worn to all worship services. These must also extend to the knee, with no revealing neck lines. **NOT ALLOWED:** Any strap type apparel is prohibited during evening services.
Dress code for Males (Worship Service): Pants or jeans and shirts with collars must be worn to all worship services. **NOT ALLOWED:** Shorts and T-shirts are prohibited during evening services.
14. No firearms, knives, weapons of any kind, matches, lighters, fireworks, etc. are permitted at camp.
15. Any camper may be expelled who violates the rules of camp. Parents and or legal guardians will be responsible for picking up their child/teen should this occur.
