### **PROGRAM INFORMATION**

**What Is STARR Leadership Challenge?** *STARR* provides a platform for both training and hands-on activities for High School students that have a desire to become "Servant Leaders" within their peer groups, local churches, and communities.

**Who Can Apply?** *STARR* is open to High School Students who are currently in the 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade when they apply.

**What Will I Learn?** *STARR* will provide students training in spiritual gifts, personal evangelism, problem solving, cultural trends and leadership skills. Students will also be able to make a difference through community service projects, summer camp preparation and summer camp activities. Upon completion of the training week held at Camp Beaverfork, participants will serve as assistants in several ministry and activity areas during the summer camp sessions.

**Duration:** Students that are accepted to the *STARR Team* will be required to attend a mandatory training week and expected to serve during all four sessions of summer camp. There will be ministry opportunities during the weekends at local FWB churches.

**2022 Dates:** Training Week begins **Monday May 30, 2022** Check in at 5:30 p.m.

Camp sessions ends **June 25, 2022** at approximately 2:00 p.m. (following clean up)

**Cost: \$350.00** The fee covers food / lodging / training supplies / travel / program specific t-shirt / and additional activities during training.

**How Can I Apply?** Each student must complete the application package and return to Camp Beaverfork by **APRIL 15**. The completed application package must include the Personal Information Form / Personal Bio / Photo / Three (3) Reference Forms. The application package can be downloaded from [www.campbeaverfork.org](http://www.campbeaverfork.org). From the home page, click on the STARR Leadership Challenge link where a printable PDF file of the **Application Package** can be found.

No application package will be accepted if it is received later than **APRIL 15<sup>th</sup>** or not complete. Remember, this is a Leadership Challenge that requires individuals to pay attention to every detail. Those accepted to the STARR Leadership Challenge will be notified in April.
